US Senator Jerry Moran will be in Belleville next Monday, April 14 at 11 a.m. for a ribbon-cutting to dedicate the new steps at Republic County Courthouse.

Sen. Moran was responsible for a \$250,000 federal appropriation from the Rural Community Facilities Act to com-

plete the replacement of the steps and sidewalks on the west and east sides of the courthouse.

The remainder of the project was funded by \$324,000 of the annual donation from NextEra Energy to Republic County.
